

The Contractor shall transport data between physically dispersed training Communities of Interest (COI) networks in accordance with the document entitled Statement of Objectives Training Communities of Interest (COI) Network Transport of 02 December 2003 and EDS proposal – Revision 2- dated 16 March 2004.

Statement of Objectives

Training Communities of Interest (COI) Network Transport

1.0 Scope

NMCI Program Management Office (PMO) has a requirement for a CLIN 0029 to transport data between physically dispersed training Communities of Interest (COIs). Training COIs do not conform to "standard" NMCI COIs and require only data transport. This service will provide interconnection of training assets.

The Contractor shall provide WAN/BAN transport service for 46 Government-identified training sites.

This service is required in order to meet all the COI requirements of the training community.

3.0 Requirements

3.1 Connectivity

The Contractor shall provide logically isolated data transport for training Communities of Interest (COIs). A Training COI may consist of multiple classrooms within multiple buildings across multiple sites. The following requirements shall apply to training network transport:

- **Intra-base transport (BAN):** Provide data transport over NMCI infrastructure for intra-base training COIs. Intra-base transport is defined as transport of network data for training COIs that reside behind a single NMCI transport boundary.
- **Inter-base transport (WAN):** Provide data transport over NMCI infrastructure for inter-base training COIs. Inter-base transport is defined as transport of network data between transport boundaries.
- **Security:** Transport of data between training COIs shall be unrestricted by IP filtering. Restrictions will be acceptable where the conceptual risk assessment identifies IA risks to the NMCI.
- **Physical Connectivity:** Connections between NMCI infrastructure and training COI assets will be mutually agreed to on a site by site basis. NETC requires support of various physical media to include:

3.2 Terms and Conditions

The Contractor will generally configure and/or install necessary mechanisms to ensure that NMCI network security is not compromised.

The Government will provide connectivity from buildings that do not have an NMCI presence to buildings that do have an NMCI presence.

The Government will provide cross-connects from GFE networks to the COI access points.

The Government will provide management of network IP address space for the training COI.

The Government will provide management and accessibility of DHCP services

The Government will provide management and accessibility of public and private DNS.

3.3 Metrics

Training COI transport interface shall meet the following metrics:

3.3.1 Scalability

The Contractor shall provide scalability of throughput to include:

- 10/100 Base-T Ethernet through Giga-bit Ethernet for the BAN;
- 1Mbps incremental pricing for WAN connectivity.

3.3.2 Technical Performance

The following SLAs specified in Appendix 2 of the NMCI Contract N00024-00-D-6000 are applicable:

- SLA 10, "NMCI Intranet Performance", shall apply to NMCI managed equipment only.
- SLA 24, "Wide Area Network (WAN) Connectivity", shall apply to NMCI managed equipment only.




Figure 1 – COI BAN and WAN Connectivity
