The purposes of the modification are to (1) revise Moves, Adds and Changes; (2) revise and add new line items; (3) revise the Statement of Objectives. For administrative convenience, this modification is separated into major sections. Accordingly make the following changes:

I. MOVES, ADDS AND CHANGES

1. The purpose of this section is to revise Moves, Adds and Changes (MACs). These changes apply to moves, adds or changes which are requested on or after the effective date of this modification.

2. Under Part One, make the following changes:

A. In Tables Three through Ten, delete Items 0026 and 0126 in their entirety and replace with:

B. Delete Note A and replace it with:

Note A –Item 0026AD (and, if option is exercised, 0126AD) can be ordered for moves of more than 20 users; a price will be negotiated and established at the time the order is placed. The negotiated task order per unit price for Item 0026AD (and, if option is exercised, 0126AD) will not exceed the per unit price for Item 0026AB (and, if option is exercised, 0126AB). Item 0026AG-AK (and 0126AG-AK, if option is exercised) shall only be used to order the annual MAC that is part of the basic seat services. The quantity ordered under the combination of Items 0026AG, 0026AH and 0026AJ (and 0126AG, 0126AH and 0126AJ, if option is exercised) may not exceed the limitation of the Statement of Objectives paragraph 3.1.13.2.5 (i.e. the number of data seats installed each Program Year). The quantity ordered under 0026AJ (and 0126AJ if option is exercised) may not exceed 15% of the total quantity of the data seats installed for the DON Enterprise for the Program Year. Beginning November 1, 2003, the Government and the Contractor shall conduct a semi-annual review of actual MAC activity

for the prior six months and evaluate whether any Item 0026 subline items should be adjusted for future periods.

C. Delete the descriptions for Item 0026 and 0026AA through 0026AD and replace with the following:

Item 0026 (and 0126, if option is exercised): **Additional Moves, Adds and Changes (MAC):** The Contractor shall perform the services described below in addition to the MACs included in the basic seat services. Changes effected pursuant to section 6.16, entitled "Technology Improvements and Refresh" shall not be considered MACs.

Item 0026AA and 0026AG (and 0126AA and 0126AG, if option is exercised): **Administrative MACs:** The Contractor shall perform administrative MACs as described in the Statement of Objectives paragraph 3.1.13. The Government may choose to purchase an administrative MAC to have the Contractor perform any of the Government-administered MACs listed in the table in the Statement of Objectives paragraph 3.1.13.2.1. This service is not available for hybrid seats or wall plug services. Item 0026AG must be ordered for tracking of the Administrative MACs used as part of the basic seat service. Optional for Items 001AA-AD, 0001AF, 0002AA-AB, 0003AA-AB, 0004AA-AC (and 0101AA-AD, 0101AF, 0102AA-AB, 0103AA-AB and 0104AA-AC if option is exercised).

Item 0026AB, 0026AH and 0026AJ (and 0126AB, 0126AH and 0126AJ if option is exercised): **Physical MACs:** The Contractor shall perform physical MACs to relocate system hardware. If requested, a physical relocation may include hardware and software de-installation, move and re-installation. If the destination location of the move does not have an existing NMCI wall plug, a wall plug item 0006AD-AF must be ordered to establish the LAN connectivity. Optional for Items 001AA-AD, 0001AF, 0002AA-AB, 0003AA-AB, 0004AA-AC (and 0101AA-AD, 0101AF, 0102AA-AB, 0103AA-AB and 0104AA-AC if option is exercised).

The Government may, without expenditure of a MAC, utilize its own resources to relocate system hardware within the same office, room or cubicle and the Contractor's local site manager shall provide an additional LAN cable to allow the unit to remain connected to the existing wall plug or to reconnect to another existing wall plug within the same office, room or cubicle. If this move results in the need for Contractor on-site intervention, then a physical MAC is required. The annual physical MAC may be used. The service is not available for hybrid seats or wall plug services.

Items 0026AH and 0026AJ (and 0126AH and 0126AJ if option is exercised) must be ordered for tracking of the physical MACs used as part of the basic seat services. Item 0026AH (and 0126AH if option is exercised), if available within the annual allotment, may be used to direct a MAC to a location with an existing NMCI wall plug. Item 0026AJ (and 0126AJ if option is exercised), if available within the annual allotment, may be used to direct a MAC to any location within an NMCI connected building, with or without an existing wall plug.

Item 0026AC and 0026AK (and 0126AC and 0126AK, if option is exercised): **Embarkable MAC:** The Contractor shall provide services, which require physical handling of the Embarkable seat, to transition an Embarkable NMCI data seat back into the NMCI domain at the customer's request. This service is available for embarkable services only. Optional for items 0003AA-004AC (and 0103AA-0104AC, if option is exercised).

Item 0026AD (and 0126AD, if option is exercised): **Project MAC:** The Contractor shall provide services to perform Project MACs, for groups of more than 20 users, which consist of system hardware and software de-installation, move and re-installation, of seats already operating in the NMCI

environment and for which the services were provided as part of the basic seat services. Project MACs will be priced on an individual task order basis; the annual physical MAC included in the basic seat services may be used, if available. The negotiated task order price will not exceed on a per unit basis the price for Item 0026AB (and if option is exercised, 0126AB). If the project MAC requires the Contractor to move or duplicate previously installed wall plugs a sufficient number of items from CLIN 0006 must be purchased if this move exceeds the 15% limitation available for annual physical MACs needing wall plugs (see Note A) or if the move is to a new building where no NMCI service currently exists. However, changes effected pursuant to section 6.16, entitled "Technology Improvements and Refresh" shall not be considered MACs. Project MACs and the times specified in SLA 15 for completing the move, will be modified to reflect the final period of performance negotiated for the task order. If the Government builds the new LAN to meet NMCI requirements, the LAN shall be transferred to the Contractor via a DD1149 and no additional CLIN 0006 items will be required. The Contractor will, as consideration for the transfer of ownership of the LAN and at no additional cost to the Government, review the cable specifications and advise to ensure compatibility and compliance with NMCI requirements. In this case, the Government will not be deemed responsible if the LAN is built to the Contractor's specifications but does not meet the SLA requirements or other Contractor expectations.

3. Under the Statement of Objectives, delete Paragraph 3.1.13, Moves, Adds and Changes (MACs), and replace it with the following:

3.1.13 Moves, Adds, and Changes (MACs)

Two categories of Moves, Adds, and Changes are provisioned under NMCI – Embarkable and User Requested. A MAC is associated with a cutover seat (a seat that is connected to the NMCI domain and receives services from the NMCI NOC). A MAC is also required under the special case during the first 90 days of an AOR period where a seat has been ordered, a connection to the NMCI network exists to support that specific seat service and the Government subsequently requests the relocation of the seat such that new NMCI network connectivity it required.

3.1.13.1 Embarkable MAC Definition:

An Embarkable MAC supports those actions required to transition an Embarkable NMCI data seat out of the NMCI domain, and those required to return that data seat to the NMCI domain. Services are to be provided for both scheduled movements that are known in advance, or contingency operations and other unplanned movements.

Each Embarkable MAC includes, but is not limited to:

- Granting of system administrator rights to DON IT personnel when the seat is embarked
- Providing a copy of the gold disk media and all authorized application software loaded on the deploying Embarkable seats
- E-mail Redirection, Forwarding, and re-implementation of full service e-mail for all accounts being deployed
- Undelivered e-mail retransmission
- Disabling and re-enabling the Common Access Card (CAC)
- Data migration capability
- Performing Help Desk functions
- Providing logistical support to meet the availability requirements of Embarked seats per SLA 1, Performance Category 2 (Availability) and Paragraph 3.7 of the SOO.
- As part of the deployment process, changes to the NMCI account other than e-mail redirection, forwarding and re-implementation of full service e-mail are not included in the Embarkable MAC.

For Embarkable NMCI seats, the Contractor will be given notification of the initial movement of a seat and one MAC will be charged per seat during the program year of that initial transition. Trained DON IT personnel will be granted system administrator rights to perform all functions required to operate and maintain that seat in an embarked environment. DON IT personnel may perform an unlimited number of configuration changes on Embarkable seats during the deployment period, to include reconnection and disconnection to the NMCI network, without incurring MAC charges. Upon return to the NMCI environment, the Contractor will automatically scan the returning seat to ensure full NMCI compatibility and provide required configuration updates. The Contractor shall provide an explanation to the user/Unit IT Representative if the scan is unable to restore the seat to full compatibility with NMCI. If the seat can be added back into NMCI without the Contractor's physical intervention, no additional MAC is charged. If the Contractor's physical intervention is required, an additional Embarkable MAC (CLIN 0026AF) will be charged. Help Desk functions for the purpose of returning Embarked seats to the NMCI environment are not considered physical intervention.

Embarkable MACs are aggregated at the Echelon II and USMC level and accounted for separately from user requested MACs.

Scope: One Embarkable MAC per seat, per program year shall be provided for items 0003AA, 0003AB, 0004AA, 0004AB and 0004AC, in addition to the user requested MAC defined below as a basic seat service.

3.1.13.2 User Requested MAC Definition:

Two categories of User Requested Move, Add, Changes (MACs) are addressed for NMCI, Administrative and Physical. Changes resulting from compliance with Section 508 where the Government via CAP is providing the assistance item (either hardware or software) to a NMCI user account or NMCI seat (Data, Voice, or Video) are not considered to be a MAC. User requested MACs are aggregated and accounted for at the Echelon II and USMC level.

For User Requested MACs, the Contractor shall provide services to perform user-requested system hardware and administrative account changes of data seats. This applies within buildings (including any physical structure such as a trailer or barge) where NMCI service already exists.

Other user requested Contractor services will be required but not charged as MACs, including:

- Acquisition and installation of any ordered CLIN, including all administrative actions necessary to establish contracted services
- Seat upgrade (Items 0007-0009), and voice upgrades (Item 0010AB and 0010AC)
- Contractor periodic or unscheduled software refresh or update

3.1.13.2.1 Administrative MAC. An administrative MAC is a logical change to a user account not associated with provisioning of an ordered CLIN as identified in the following tables. Administrative MACs are separated into three categories: Government Administered (not charged as a MAC), Contractor Administered (not charged as a MAC), and Contractor Administered (charged as a MAC). Contractor Administered (charged as a MAC) MACs, and Government Administered MACs (not charged as a MAC) that the Contractor performs at the request of the Government will be deducted from the pool of MACs provided within the basic seat service or must be purchased via Item 0026AA (or Item 0126AA, if option is exercised).

The following table identifies the administrative MACs that are Government Administered and the administrative MACs that are Contractor Administered.

* Contractor administered are changes to "key fields" within the active directory that are required to establish a unique user identity and user account management profile. Government administered MACs are changes to discretionary information fields that will be maintained by the customer.

Name and role changes for government administrators are chargeable as Administrative MACs and can only be made by the Contractor. Government personnel shall also be assigned responsibility for administering changes to the items listed below:

- Management of previously Contractor established shared files, public folders or communities of interest (COI) (which require no additional hardware).
- Additions or deletions to the membership associated with shared file, public folder or COI.
- User requested changes to a user account to include access privileges

No Administrative MAC is required for distribution of Contractor provided software (e.g. - gold disk software or software provided via CLIN 0023). Distribution of GFE or legacy applications will only be performed at the direction of the customer. Distribution will be performed by the Contractor as the result of either a user requested Administrative MAC or can be separately ordered via CLIN 0023 item "Software Distribution", except that no MAC is required when a scheduled distribution is performed pursuant to Statement of Objectives paragraph 3.1.14, Software Distribution and Upgrades.

3.1.13.2.2 Physical MAC. A Physical MAC is a user requested and approved movement of an NMCI supported asset. A physical MAC includes de-installation, move, and re-installation, or change of data seat hardware and all related logical changes associated with the physical move, not associated with provisioning of an ordered CLIN. The times specified in SLA 15 for accomplishing a move will not apply to project moves; the time for completing the move will be negotiated as part of the resulting order.

3.1.13.2.3 Voice MAC. A user requested and approved system hardware and software de-installation, move and reinstallation. Administrative changes, which do not require a visit to the customer location, will be performed by the Contractor and do not constitute a MAC. Administrative changes include, but are not limited to, change of voice mail name, or password, call forwarding, call transfer; assignment of class of service (i.e. enable or restrict the capability of a voice seat to place local, long distance or DSN calls); or change of telephone number. This service is available for voice seats only.

3.1.13.2.4 Video MAC – A user requested and approved system hardware and software de-installation, move and re-installation. This service is available for Video seats only.

3.1.13.2.5 Scope. One user requested MAC per year shall be provided for each installed data, video, or voice seat as a basic seat service. .

A. Under CLINs 0006 and 0106, revise the description to read:

Item 0006 (and 0106 if option is exercised): **Additional Wall Plug Service:** This service provides access to the NMCI in the form of a wall plug which allows direct, local connectivity to NMCI in accordance with the security requirements and policy of this contract. This service is an extension of the NMCI network and can be ordered for (1) all NMCI seats except a basic hybrid seat and (2) DAA approved devices as restricted by the individual CLIN service description. The purchase of an additional wall plug line item is not required if it is to support a move to a location with an existing NMCI wall plug or if it is intended to support an annual physical MAC item 0026AH or 0026AJ. Additional classified wall plug service shall only be ordered at sites that already contain classified seats. This service is an extension of the NMCI wall plug and can be ordered for all NMCI seats except a basic hybrid seat.

Item 0006AA: **Additional Standard Wall Plug Service:** Note - This item is not available for ordering after 28 April 2003. This service provides access to the NMCI in the form of a wall plug. This service allows an NMCI data seat user to have direct, local connectivity to NMCI in accordance with the security requirements and policy of this contract. This service is an extension of the NMCI infrastructure. This service from the wall plug can be used by all NMCI ordered seats except a basic hybrid seat.

Item 0006AB (and 0106AB if option is exercised): **Additional Unclassified Wall Plug – Service Only:** This service provides additional unclassified access to the NMCI through an existing (previously installed) NMCI wall plug. This service is an extension of the unclassified NMCI connectivity and can be ordered for (1) all unclassified NMCI seats (except a basic hybrid seat), (2) a single unclassified workstation/data seat and (3) a single shared unclassified printer. The following items may not be attached using this service: (1) networks, (2) servers, (3) sensors, and (4) devices with high bandwidth requirements. DAA approval is required for any attached device. If an NMCI unclassified wall plug does not exist, installation of the unclassified NMCI wall plug is first required, via Item 0006AD. All NMCI ordered unclassified data seats except a basic hybrid seat can use the service from this wall plug.

Item 0006AC (and 0106AC if option is exercised): **Additional Classified Wall Plug – Service Only:** This service provides additional classified access to the NMCI through an existing (previously installed) NMCI wall plug. This service is an extension of the classified NMCI connectivity and can be ordered for (1) all classified NMCI seats (except a basic hybrid seat), (2) a single classified workstation/data seat and (3) a single shared classified printer. The following items may not be attached using this service: (1) networks, (2) servers, (3) sensors, and (4) devices with high bandwidth requirements. DAA approval is required for any attached device. If an NMCI classified wall plug does not exist, installation of the classified NMCI wall plug is first required via Item 0006AE or Item 0006AF. All NMCI ordered classified data seats except a basic hybrid seat can use the service from this wall plug.

Item 0006AD (and 0106AD if option is exercised): **Unclassified Wall Plug:** This service provides an additional unclassified LAN wall plug beyond those provided with (1) all unclassified NMCI seats (except a basic hybrid seat); (2) a single unclassified workstation/data seat and

(3) a single shared unclassified printer. The following items may not be attached using this service: (1) networks; (2) servers; (3) sensors; and (4) devices with high bandwidth requirements. DAA approval is required for any attached device. This service, in conjunction with Item 0006AB, will allow direct, local connectivity to unclassified NMCI services in accordance with the security requirements and policy of this contract. This service does not include upgrading an existing switch to support this additional wall plug. If a switch providing NMCI unclassified service is not already in place that can support this additional wall plug, additional services will be required via Item 0006AG. This service only provides wall plug support for the inside cable plant. Access to NMCI services is provided by the basic seat service price if the wall plug is the primary wall plug for the seat. If the wall plug is an additional wall plug beyond that provided with the seat (e.g. – conference room), service must be separately ordered via Item 0006AB.

This service must be placed within an area where an NMCI-managed classified switch and TACLANE already exist. If a switch providing classified service is not already in place that can support this additional wall plug, an existing encryption device must be available or additionally provided as GFE, and additional services will be required via Item 0006AG. This service only provides support for the inside cable plant. All requests for service require DAA approval prior to service delivery. Access to NMCI services is provided by the basic seat service price if the wall plug is the primary wall plug for the seat. If the wall plug is an additional wall plug beyond that provided with the seat (e.g. – conference room), service must be separately ordered via Item 0006AC.

This service must be placed within an area where an NMCI-managed classified switch and TACLANE already exist. If a switch providing classified service is not already in place that can support this additional wall plug, an existing encryption device must be available or additionally provided as GFE, and additional services will be required via Item 0006AG. This service only provides support for the inside cable plant. All requests for service require DAA

approval prior to service delivery. Access to NMCI services is provided by the basic seat service price if the wall plug is the primary wall plug for the seat. If the wall plug is an additional wall plug beyond that provided with the seat (e.g. – conference room), service must be separately ordered via Item 0006AC.

If Mission Critical support is only required for either the Classified or the Unclassified service provided with Items 0009AB-AH (and 0109AB-AH, if option is exercised), only item 0008AA (and 0108AA if option is exercised) is required.”

III. CONTRACT PROVISIONS

The purpose of this section is to revise provisions under Part Two as follows:

1. Under paragraph 5.3, Cancellation Under Multi-Year Contracts, the second subparagraph, revise the cancellation ceilings for PY06 and PY07 as follows: “PY06 - \$549.1M and PY07 - \$378.5M”.

2. Under paragraph 6.26, Shared Savings, add the following sentence after the existing paragraph:

“EDS will provide the baseline data required by this paragraph by 28 May 2003 and will provide the updated information beginning 4 August 2003.”

3. Under paragraph 5.5, delete “Jeffrey Naus” as an alternate COR.

4. Under paragraph 6.35, Undefined Contractual Actions (UCAs), revise the last sentence of the first subparagraph to read: “The parties agree that the following three clauses are incorporated, by reference, into each UCA task order.”

IV. STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this section is to revise the statement of Objectives (SOO) as follows:

1. Under SOO 2.1, Data Seats, at the end of the first paragraph, add the sentence: “The Contractor shall provide surge protectors, as it deems necessary. The Contractor shall replace a non-functioning battery within 12 months of date of initial seat installation with a working battery for portable seats to ensure the portable remains in working condition when unplugged from its electrical source. Users may purchase additional batteries under CLIN 0023.”

2. Under SOO 3.1.4, Web Access and Proxy and Caching Services, after the third sentence, add a fourth sentence to read: The Contractor shall add links to applications that were certified under the Task Force Web effort to the NMCI portal.

2. Under SOO 3.1.19, Web Hosting, revise the paragraph to read:

“Requirement: Web hosting is a service provided for Navy and Marine Corps web sites, including storage and processing of web content. This service includes NMCI internal access, public access, and classified hosting. As part of this service, Contractor must provide statistics regarding web access. The service does not include authoring web content and application development. The Contractor shall host web pages or provide a web address (URL), as requested by the Government. The Contractor shall host both static and dynamic web pages; the Government will continue to manage the web content and will provide any applications necessary to allow the dynamic pages to operate as designed. All applications and services accessed via the portal must comply with the NMCI portal guidelines. If the Contractor hosts the web sitepage, the space required for that effort shall be allotted from the shared space allocated to the users of the site; the Government may purchase additional storage space as needed via CLIN 0016AA/AB. If the Government provides the server on which the web site page is hosted or if the

Contractor provides a URL to the Government hosted web site the Government is not required to purchase additional storage space.

Scope: Basic service with all data seats.”

4. Under SOO paragraph 3.1.14, Software Distribution and Upgrade, revise the first sentence to read:
Requirement: The Contractor shall provide the capability to distribute new and upgraded software as described in the Application Release Process contained in the NRDDG.”

A CONFORMED COPY OF THE CONTRACT IS MADE A PART OF THIS MODIFICATION AS A RESULT OF THE CHANGES MADE HEREIN.

All other terms and conditions of the contract remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
