

TOPIC: Backup Power to NMCI Facilities

ISSUE:

- Paragraph 5.6 of the contract states that “Backup power shall be part of the fit-up of facilities provided by the contractor in cases where it does not exist or does not meet the contractor’s specifications.”
- There may be instances when the Government and EDS find it mutually beneficial to share a backup power source, and responsibilities must be determined.

DECISION:

- The Government will not provide secondary power feeds to the buildings, including secondary transformers and transmission infrastructure. EDS will provide, at no cost to the Government, all required permits, air pollution control credits, and fuel needed for installation and operation of EDS installed backup generators. (Some permits may need to be completed by the Contractor and submitted by the Government to the regulatory agency.)
- In instances where a generator and fuel are shared, the Government and Contractor will mutually agree on a prorata usage cost.
