

Rear Admiral Munns, USN **Director, Navy Marine Corps Intranet**

Rear Admiral Munns is Director, Navy Marine Corps Intranet reporting directly to the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Research, Development and Acquisition). After graduation from the Naval Academy his duty assignments included Commanding Officer of *USS Richard B. Russell* (SSN-687); a Pentagon tour on the OPNAV Staff; and Commander, Submarine Development Squadron. He was then selected as a CNO Strategic Studies Group Fellow. His tasking was to create innovative operational concepts for Naval Operations in 2025 and beyond. He was detailed to serve as Chief of Staff, Commander Submarine Force U. S. Pacific Fleet.



Rear Adm. Munns' first Flag Officer tour was as Deputy Chief of Staff for C4I, Resources, Requirements, and Assessments on the staff of the Commander-in-Chief, U. S. Pacific Fleet where he acted as the Pacific Fleet Chief Information Officer and Chief Financial Officer. In June 2000, Rear Adm. Munns was named Commander Submarine Group Eight; Commander Submarines, Allied Naval Forces South; Commander, Submarine Force SIXTH Fleet; and Commander, Fleet Ballistic Missile Submarine Force, based in Naples, Italy.

Rear Adm. Munns received a Masters degree in Computer Science from the University of Colorado and attended MIT's Seminar XXI on Foreign Politics and International Relations.
